

EMERGE COVID-19 and Gender Questions Education

The COVID-19 pandemic and the social containment efforts to manage the spread of the virus (lockdown, curfew, and other social distancing efforts) have resulted in many schools closing or having to participate in school online. We would like to ask you about each child in your household who is or should be in school to understand their situation.

1. Do you have children in the household between the ages of 6 and 18 years of age?
 - a. Yes
 - b. No (if no, go to next section)

Note to Researcher: Please indicate each of the children age 6-18 year in the table below by initial and then ask the respondent the questions in the table for each child.
