We remain committed to evidence-based measures at scale, and we hope to continue to work jointly with large-scale survey researchers on this endeavor this year.



Findings from our [COVID-19 data collection and measures harmonization efforts](#) of 2020 and 2021, undertaken in collaboration with additional research and programmatic organizations, will be released soon. As a reminder, we have [18 survey modules on COVID-19 and Gender](#) that are freely available on our website.

Strides have been made in how we measure family planning (FP) outcomes, focusing on agency and norms among women and couples in addition to conventional outcomes, such as contraception use. Do keep an eye out for our paper describing the findings from [CHARM2](#), a gender equity+FP intervention in Maharashtra, India. Similar to our work on COVID-19, we have available for public use [four survey modules on gender and family planning](#) and [four survey modules on gender and social norms](#).
